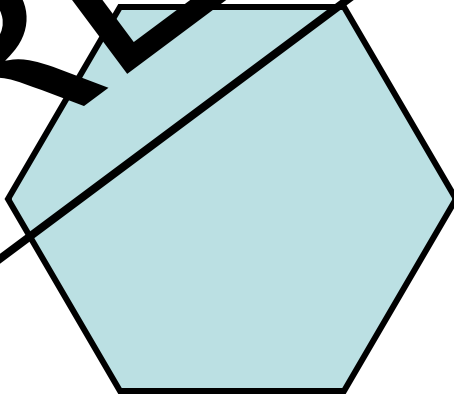
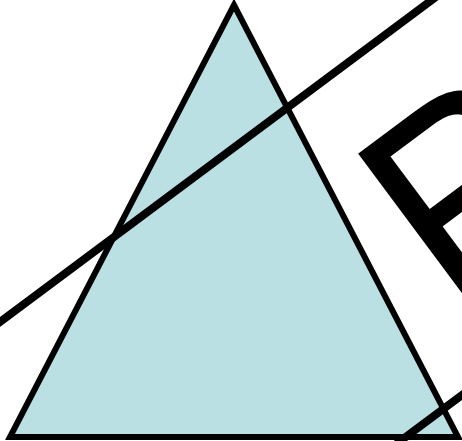
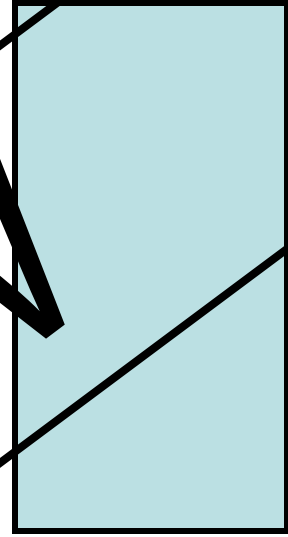
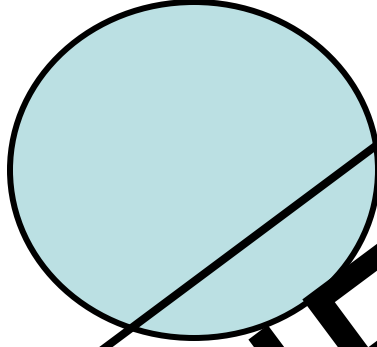
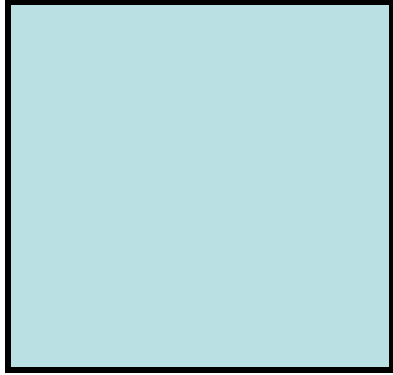
A Sorting or Memory Match Game

Directions: **Sorting Game:** Reproduce each page on 3 or 4 different colors of heavy paper such as construction paper or card stock. Laminate, if desired, and cut apart. Students use the cards to sort by size, color, and/or shape.

Match Game: The cards may also be used to play a memory match game. Use one color of cards with both large and small shapes. Lay them all face down on a flat surface or put in a pocket chart. Children take turns flipping over 2 cards to see if the shapes match. If no match, cards are placed face down again and another student tries to match 2 cards from memory.

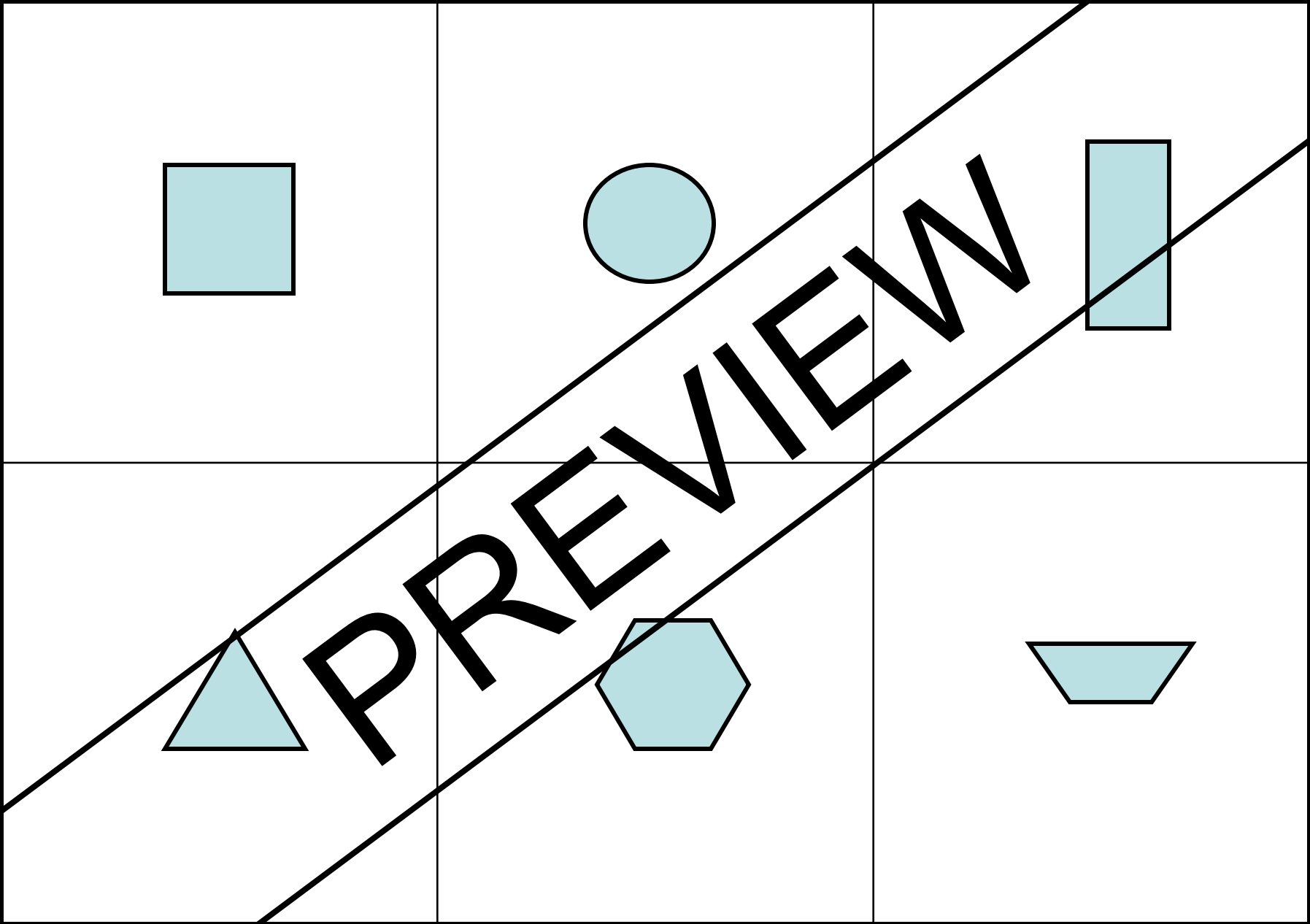
