

APPLES



MATERIALS

Scissors
Glue
9x12 construction paper: royal blue, brown, yellow, red,
white, light green, and green

*Patterns will also work on 12x18 construction paper if they are enlarged 141% on the copy machine.

PREPARATION

1. Run patterns on pages 4-5 on card stock.
2. Cut out patterns and paper clip each set together.
3. Give each group of 4 to 6 children a set of patterns to share.
4. Have the children then trace the patterns on to construction paper, cut them out, then assemble to project.

-OR-

1. Run patterns on pages 6-9 on the appropriate colors of construction paper.
2. Cut the patterns apart to distribute needed patterns to each child.
3. Have the children finish cutting and assemble the project.

PROCEDURES FOR ASSEMBLING THE PROJECT



1. Glue yellow and green apples side by side on to a piece of royal blue construction paper.



2. Glue red apple on to the center of the yellow and green apples.



3. Glue a brown stem on to the green, red, and yellow apples. Glue the white center of the apple on to the red apple.



4. Glue the light green leaf on to the green apple. Glue the green leaf on to the yellow apple. Glue the five brown seeds on to the middle of the white inside of the red apple.
