

BEACH BALL AND SAND PAIL



MATERIALS

Scissors

Glue

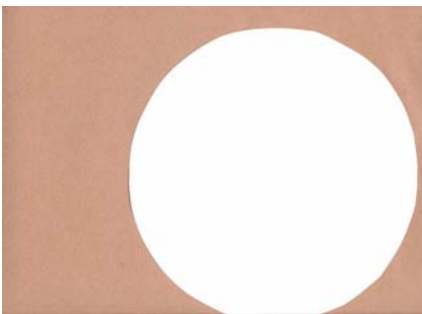
9x12 construction paper: orange, light brown, red, white, royal blue, yellow, and green

*Patterns will also work on 12x18 construction paper if they are enlarged 141% on the copy machine.

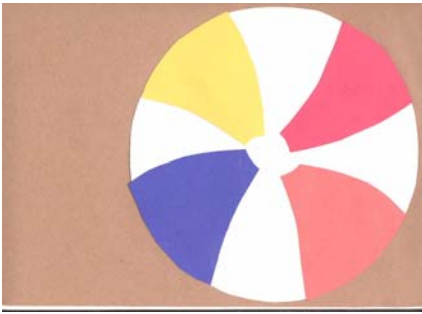
PREPARATION

1. Run patterns on pages 4-9 on card stock.
2. Cut out patterns and paper clip each set together.
3. Give each group of 4 to 6 children a set of patterns to share.
4. Have the children then trace the patterns on to construction paper, cut them out, -
OR-
 1. Run patterns on pages 7-15 on the appropriate colors of construction paper.
 2. Cut the patterns apart to distribute needed patterns to each child.
 3. Have the children finish cutting and assemble the project. Then assemble to project.

PROCEDURES FOR ASSEMBLING THE PROJECT



1. Glue white beach ball on to the light brown construction paper.



2. Glue the red, orange, blue, and yellow sections on to the white beach ball leaving a white section in between each colored section.



3. Glue the green center on to the middle of the beach ball.



4. Glue the green shovel's handle to the **wrong side** of the red sand pail. Glue one of the ends of the blue sand pail's handle to the **wrong side** of the red sand pail near the end of the green shovel's handle.



5. Glue the other blue sand pail's handle to the **right side** of the red sand pail. Glue the red sand pail and the green shovel to the light brown construction paper overlapping the beach ball.



6. Glue the blue trim on to the top of the red sand pail. Glue the other blue trim to the bottom of the red sand pail. Glue the yellow star to the center of the red sand pail.
