

DUMP TRUCK



MATERIALS

Scissors

Glue

9x12 construction paper: royal blue, yellow, red, orange, brown, and black

*Patterns will also work on 12x18 construction paper if they are enlarged 141% on the copy machine.

PREPARATION

1. Run patterns on pages 3-4 on card stock.
2. Cut out patterns and paper clip each set together.
Cut out patterns and paper clip each set together.
3. Give each group of 4 to 6 children a set of patterns to share.
4. Have the children then trace the patterns on to construction paper, cut them out, then assemble to project.

-OR-

1. Run patterns on pages 6-10 on the appropriate colors of construction paper.
2. Cut the patterns apart to distribute needed patterns to each child.
3. Have the children finish cutting and assemble the project.

PROCEDURES FOR ASSEMBLING THE PROJECT



1. Glue the yellow container pattern on to the royal blue construction paper. Next glue the three orange stripes on to the yellow container dividing it into three sections.



2. Glue brown dirt pattern on top of yellow container pattern covering overlapping orange stripes.



3. Glue the yellow trim to the top of the yellow container covering bottom section of the brown dirt.



4. Glue the rectangular yellow trim to the bottom of the yellow container pattern and the royal blue construction paper, overlapping the three orange stripes.



5. Glue the two blue window patterns on to the yellow cab pattern. Next glue the yellow cab pattern on to the royal blue construction paper and attach it to the container portion of truck.



5. Glue black wheels on to the dump truck and the red headlight on to the front of the cab. Glue the red tail light on to the back of the dump truck.
