

# Activity Name: Driving Me Crazy!

## Skill/Objective: Subtraction Facts

### Directions:

1. Get a piece of blank paper and choose a Subtraction Story strip from the zip bag.
2. Glue the Story Strip to the top of your blank paper.
3. Now get a paper with pictures of cars.
4. Read the subtraction story. Cut out enough cars to act out your story.
5. Then glue your cars to your paper, and write the subtraction number fact on our paper. You might want to put an X on the cars that you subtracted, or show them driving away.
6. Finish your project by drawing the background to go with your story.



### Materials-

- Reproduce the page of cars. Each child will need only part of a page.
- Reproduce the subtraction story strips. Each child will need only 1 strip from the page.
- Blank paper for background
- Glue or glue stick
- Scissors
- Crayons

Reproduce enough for each student to choose 1 story strip.

Cut apart and place in zip bag.

There were 6 cars in front of my house. Then 3 drove away. How many were left?

There were 5 cars by the big tree. Then 4 drove away. How many were left?

One day 4 cars were going down the street. Then 3 of them turned the corner. How many were left?

There were 6 cars at the grocery store. Then 1 car drove away. How many were left?

There were 5 cars by the big old tree. Then 2 cars drove away. How many were left by the old tree?

There were 4 cars at the gas station. Then 2 went away. How many cars were left?

There were 3 cars at McDonald's buying hamburgers. Then 1 went home. How many were left?
