

Activity: Grandpa Diego

Skill/Objective: Addition Facts to 5

Directions:

1. Get a Grandpa Diego paper, the addition cards, and some seeds.
2. You will also need a pencil and some glue. *Do not use a glue stick.*
3. Choose a card and write the addition fact near a picture of Grandpa Diego.
4. Now count out seeds to show the number of seeds Grandpa Diego will plant there. Glue the seeds in the dirt by Grandpa Diego. *Do not use a glue stick.*
5. Solve the addition fact and write the answer.
6. Do the same thing for the other pictures of Grandpa Diego to help him plant his garden.

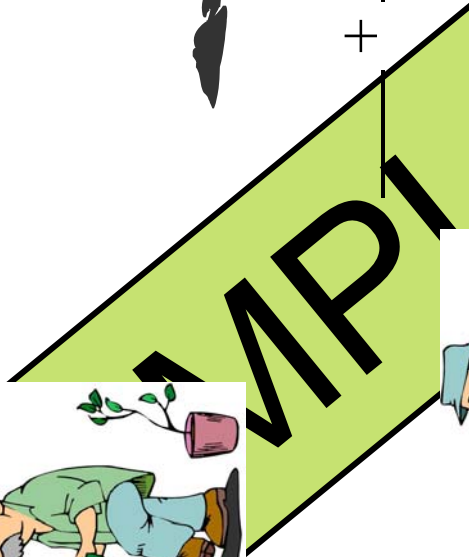
Addition to 5
