

My Phonics Sticker Book

When you reproduce this book, you'll need to cut the pages into fourths, collate and bind. Print as many as you need for a group and use with the alphabet stickers included. Students can "read" their sticker book, saying the name of the picture and the capital and lower case letters while pointing. This builds 1 to 1 recognition and provides an anchor for automaticity in letter recognition. Allow students to keep these throughout the year and add stickers each month. You can have students paste the letters onto larger half-sheets of construction paper to give them more room to add stickers.

Alphabet Sticker Book Instructions

Alphabet Cover Page (4 to each page)

Alphabet pages A-Z

Four Full pages of graphics to print as stickers

There are many other uses you can incorporate with these materials. Students can also write or paste words to each individual page. Although I created this unit for Kindergarten, it can be altered and used for preK-3nd grade. Have lots of Fun!
