Noun (N)- things

hamster

Adjective (Adj)- Describes the noun

My hamster is very cute.

My cute hamster likes to bite me.

Pronoun (Pro)- takes place of noun

she

us

it

Proper Noun (Prop)- Capitalized; a name

Jason Smith

Oakland Raiders

Beaverton, Oregon

Preposition (Prep)- shows position; where something's at

next to

inside

over

Interjection (Int)- an energetic word or phrase to show feeling

"Darn!" "Oh, man!" "Wow!"

Conjunction (Conj) joins parts of a sentence together

I love my dog, and he loves me.

Don't slap your poodle when you're angry, besides she loves you.

Verb (V)- shows action

My hamster barfed in her wheel

Adverb (Adv)- Describes the verb; how the verb happened

My hamster barfed wildly in her wheel
