

Activity: **Pocketful of Money**

Skill/Objective: **Identifying & Counting Coins**

Directions:

1. Get a paper bag of plastic coins and a **Pocketful of Money** sheet.
2. Reach in the bag and pull out a few coins, about 5.
3. Draw and label the coins you pulled out. (Do not draw a coin until you have labeled it by writing 1¢, 5¢, 10¢, or 25¢.)
4. Count how much you have in the bag.
5. Continue pulling coins from the bag and record your pocket full.

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
Materials –
