

# POETRY PORTFOLIO

For the final unit of study this year you'll be putting together a *Poetry Portfolio*, which is a collection of mentor poems, original poems and reflections on other poets' poems. Your Portfolio will be housed in a three-ring binder with tabs that say "mentor texts," "originals," and "reflections."

Here are the guidelines for the Portfolio:

## A MENTOR POEMS – 4 Poems + 1 Craft Table

- You must have FOUR mentor poems in this folder.
  - Type, hand-copy or photocopy of each poem.
- Fill out a "Poetry Craft Table" Worksheet in order to demonstrate your understanding of the poetic devices the poets used when they crafted their poems.
  - It should be clear, upon viewing the mentor poems **and** your craft table, how you used these poems as mentors.

## B ORIGINAL POETRY – 8 Poems

### MANDATORY POEMS:

2. Wondering Poem
3. Bubble Poem
4. List Poem
