

# Activity: Race Car Rally!

## Skill/Objective: Number Order 1-100

### Directions:

1. Get a **Race Car Rally** paper, a pencil, scissors and glue.
2. First complete Race 1 and Race 2 by looking at the numbers on the cars and writing them in the correct order on the lines. You might want to look at a number line or a hundreds chart to help you.
3. Next cut off the bottom of the paper for Challenge Race.
4. Lay the cars in the correct number order on the back of your paper. You may want to make them in a loop as though they are on a real race track.
5. When you are sure they are in the right order, glue them to your paper.

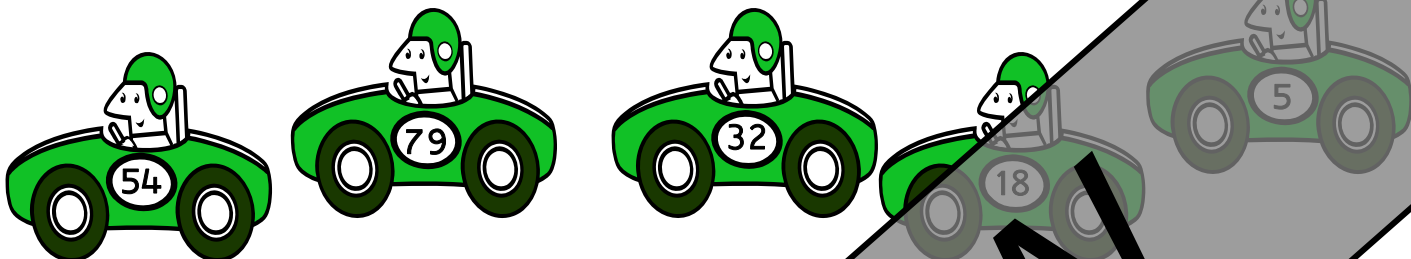

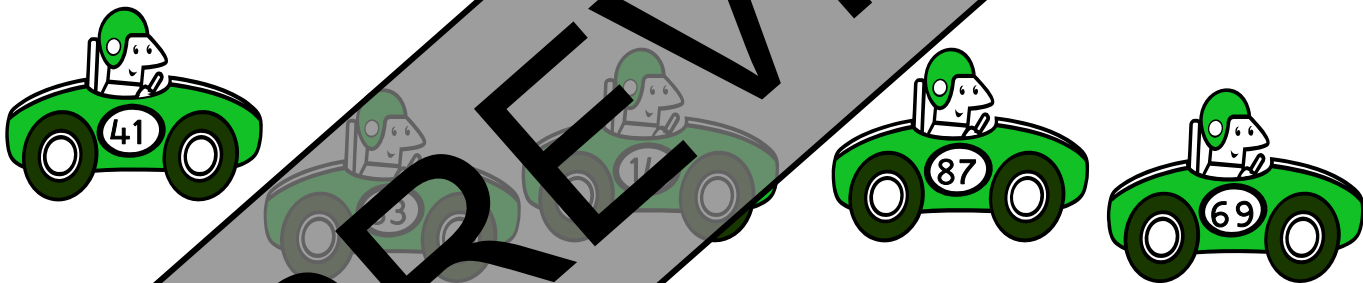
Look at the numbers on the cars in each row for Race 1 and Race 2.

Race No. 1: from **least to greatest**



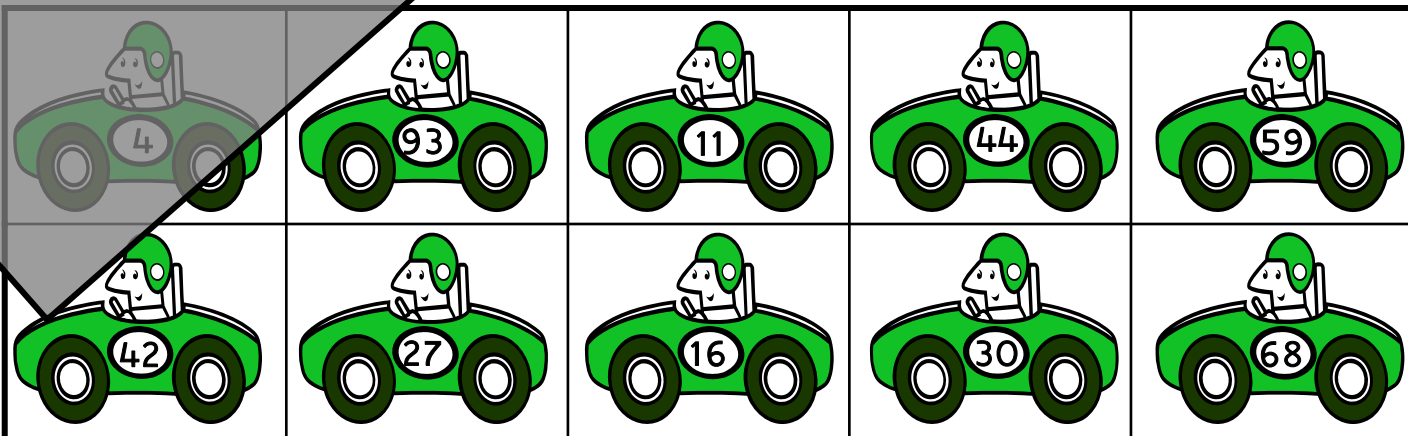
