

Activity: Rub-A-Dub-Dub, Bears In The Tub

Skill/Objective: Subtraction Facts from 7

Directions:

1. Get a Bears In The Tub paper and some counting bears.
2. You will also need crayons.
3. Use your counting bears to practice showing the number at the bottom of the page. Say the math fact as you draw the bears and take away the number of bears shown.
4. Say the math fact as a number sentence. Draw the bears in the tub. 3 bears get out. There is 4 bears left.
5. Choose another math fact and practice subtracting the tub as you practice subtracting.
6. Now choose one math fact and a crayon. Draw bears to show how many were in the tub. Draw an X on each bear as you "take it away".
7. Write the number sentence for the subtraction sentence that you circled.

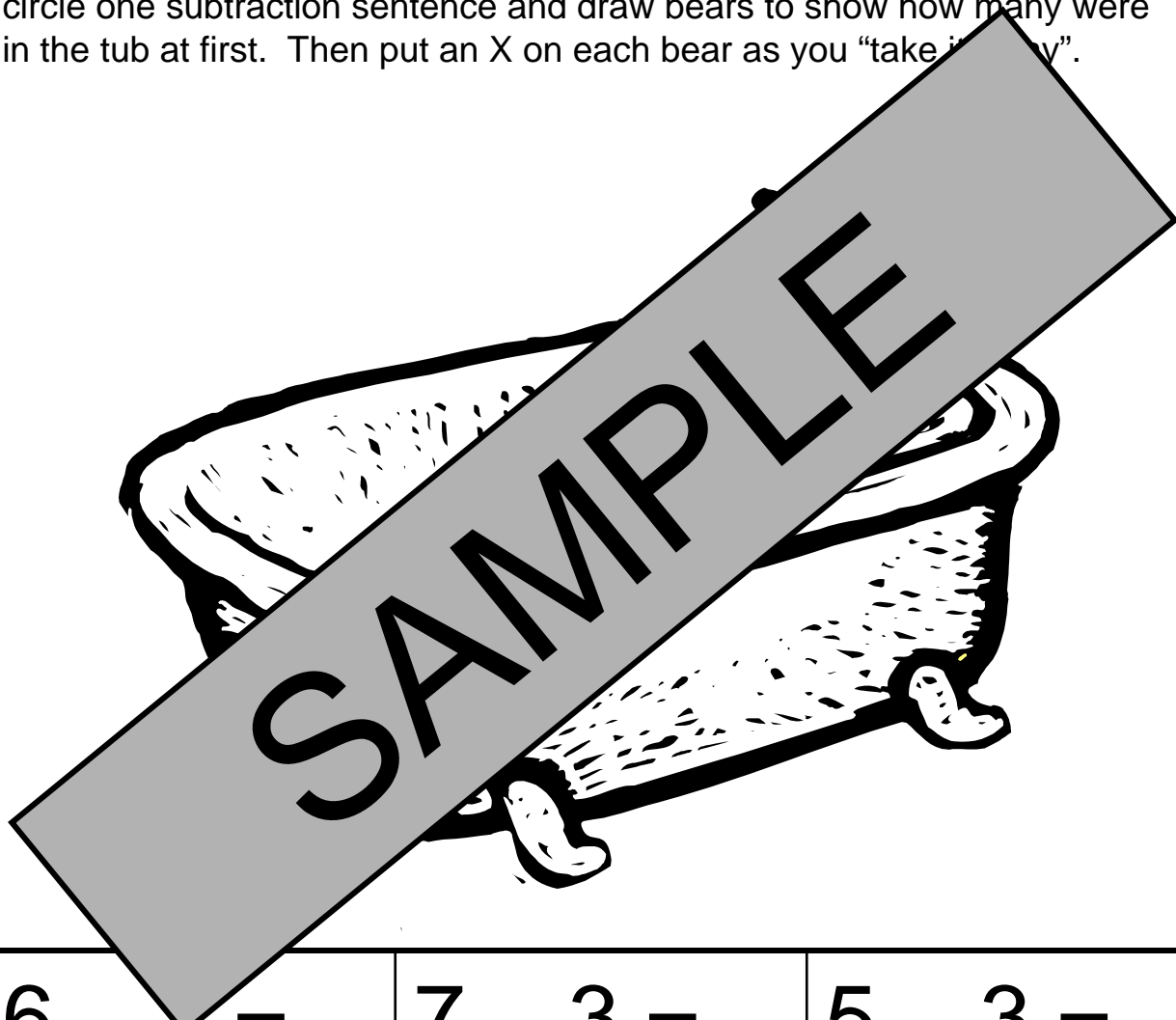
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MATERIALS-
