1. During summer vacation we went to the beach 3 times in June, 6 times in July, and 2 times in August. How many times did we go to the beach in all?



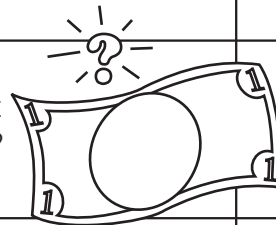

3. Tony rakes leaves for 6 people on Saturdays. By lunch time he had four of the yards done. How many yards did he have left to rake after lunch?

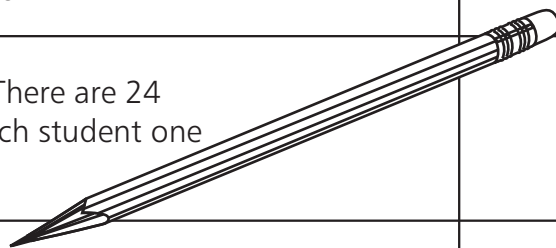
4. Our class has recess twice a day. We went to school four days last week. How many recesses did we have last week?
